Federal Council eases coronavirus measures

26.05.2021

Stabilisation phase begins on 31 May. Now applicable:



Reopened:



Restaurants and bars



Spas and thermal baths



Easing of restrictions for private gatherings

Indoors: up to 30 people
Outdoors: up to 50 people



Easing of restrictions for events

50

In general up to 50 people



Public attendance (sports and cultural events), religious services



Indoors: up to 100 people and 1/2 of venue capacity



Outdoors: up to 300 people and 1/2 of venue capacity



Easing of restrictions for sports and cultural activities

Up to 50 people at amateur sports and cultural events. Public allowed at matches.



No capacity restrictions for face-to-face teaching

Prerequisite: approved testing plan. Applies for higher and adult education institutions



Quarantine no longer required for those vaccinated

Applies for contact and travel quarantine



Easing of requirement to work from home

Working from home a recommendation rather than requirement for companies that test regularly

Still applicable:



Closed: clubs and discos



Large-scale events banned (except pilot events)



Recommendation: Get yourself tested!

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CAPACITY-RELATED MEASURES

- All guests must remain seated while eating and drinking.
- The spacing between seats and the maximum number of four guests per table indoors and six outdoors must comply with the rules. A distance of 1.5 metres is to be maintained between tables.
- We kindly ask you to maintain a distance of 1.5 metres from other guests and from employees.

HYGIENE MEASURES

- Please disinfect your hands when entering the restaurant. Hand hygiene stations are available at the entrances of the individual food and beverage outlets.
- Trays, credit card terminals and bill folders are cleaned by us after each service step. The menus are disposed of after each use.
- Print materials such as newspapers and magazines, etc. are not available at the moment.
- Wherever possible, we avoid using shared utensils (e.g. salt cellars and pepper pots, cutlery baskets and butter dishes) or clean them after each guest.
- We are no longer allowing coats or other wardrobe items to be handed in at cloakrooms. You are welcome to take these items with you to your table.
- Only healthy employees are allowed to come to work. We therefore ask that our guests visit us only if they are completely healthy.
